

# "All Things Post Rock"

## 2010 Rush County Fair Special Photography Contest

### Contest Rules

1. Contest is open to all 4-H and Open Class participants.
2. The subject of the photograph must be post rock or post rock related and located within Rush County, KS.
3. Photographs must be taken by the exhibitor
4. Exhibitors are limited to 2 entries, per class.
5. All entries must be submitted with a completed official entry form. Entry form includes a release allowing RCHS to take ownership of the photograph and gives RCHS permission to display the photographs at the Rush County Post Rock Museum and any other venue.
6. Photographs will be judged on two primary elements, the combined scores of each element will be used to determine winners.
  - a. Photographic Composition
  - b. Historical Aspects
7. Photographs will be divided into three age categories for judging: Youth (17 and under), Adult (18+) and Professional (as defined in the Rush County Fair book).
8. Photographs may be submitted in one of the following categories: Buildings (all or partial post rock), Quarries (working or abandoned), Bridges, Fences (or Fence Post), Others.
9. Photographs are to adhere to the following rules in mounting and presentation.
  - a. Black & White and color photographs may be entered. Any type of camera may be used.
  - b. Photographs must be no larger than 8"x10" and no smaller than 7"x9".
  - c. Photographs must be permanently mounted on 11"x12.5" white studio mount (available at the Rush County Extension Office). Do not use foam core or poster board.
    - i. Top edge of the print must be 1" below the top of the mount board and centered equal distance from the sides of the mount.
    - ii. Prints must be mounted across the narrow (11") side of the mount.
    - iii. Photographs may be mounted vertically or horizontally.
  - d. Prohibited: frames and glass, lettering, white borders on print
  - e. All other mounting and presentation rules for Open Class Photography also apply.
10. Ribbons and Awards will be given for the following placings: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> class placing for each age category, Grand and Reserve Champion overall in Youth and Adult/Professional.

Cash premiums for each class placing: 1<sup>st</sup> \$20, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$10  
Cash premiums for Grand Champion & Reserve Champion:  
Grand Champion (Youth & Adult/Professional) additional \$10  
Reserve Grand Champion (Youth & Adult/Professional) additional \$5
