Photos will be scanned while you wait –you keep your originals or you may donate them to the Society.

1. The individual should be Rush County native, have had residence in the county, or have some other direct connection with Rush County
2. Individual should be pictured in uniform
3. Pictures of Veterans or active duty personnel accepted
We are seeking photos from the Civil War to the present

4. We would also like a short biography including rank, dates of service, awards, and other pertinent information. You may include as little or as much information as you wish.*

*Some items you may wish to share include: Copies of discharge records, stories of personal experiences, awards and commendations, candid photos (you may bring more than 1 photo)

5. At the conclusion of the exhibition, photos and biographies will be added **TO THE SOCIETY’S PERMANENT COLLECTIONS.**

6. Out of respect for our service men and women, photos will not be judged at the fair. All who have served our country deserve equal honor.
